- Have a lesson in our school room with blackboard, wooden desks, ink wells, pens and pencils.
- Hand-wash socks in metal tubs using a scrubbing board and peg them out to dry on a rope clothes line.
- Visit a laundry where the laundry tubs are made of concrete and the copper is used to boil the dirty clothes.
- Learn how we cooked in a pre-electric kitchen and set a dining table for a meal.
- Shop at a corner shop where the grocer serves you with your purchases.
- See how bath water was heated in the bathroom.
